The console supports sample rates up to 96kHz, delivering high-resolution audio for precise and detailed mixing.

The FX RACK includes 43 professionalgrade effects, among which the newly developed REV HD and REV R3 reverbs stand out.

A dedicated 7-inch Utility screen ensures that important elements such as the Scene List. User Defined Kevs. and Meters are always visible and accessible for fast operation.
br/>ln terms of design, the console features an ergonomic layout that enhances usability. The fader surfaces are equipped with strip lights, while the side pad design minimizes light leakage and accidental contact with controls, making the DM7 ideal for dimly lit environments. The placement of buttons, knobs, and graphical elements is consistent with other Yamaha mixers, ensuring familiarity

for users transitioning between models. Additionally, the DM7 is compact and lightweight, making it easy to transport and set up without compromising on functionality or display visibility.
br/>one of the standout features of the DM7 is its integration with Dante networking. supporting up to 144 input and output channels. This allows seamless connection with Yamaha R Series I/O Racks and various Danteenabled devices, making it an adaptable solution for different setups. The console also features Yamaha's unique Split Mode, which divides input channels, scenes, and mix buses, effectively allowing one DM7 to function as two separate mixers. This is particularly useful in applications where multiple engineers need independent control over their mixes.
br/>to assist users in setting up and optimizing their mix, the DM7 includes an Assist Function that provides suggestions for head amp adjustments, naming, and fader balance. This feature helps to reduce preparation time, allowing engineers to focus more on creativity and performance.
